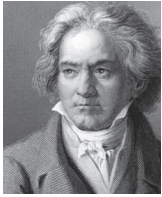

Brahms Piano Concerto No. 2

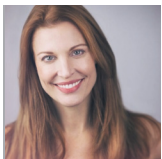
Adam Neiman brings pianistic power, virtuosity, and musical insight - a perfect combination for Brahms' glorious concerto.
